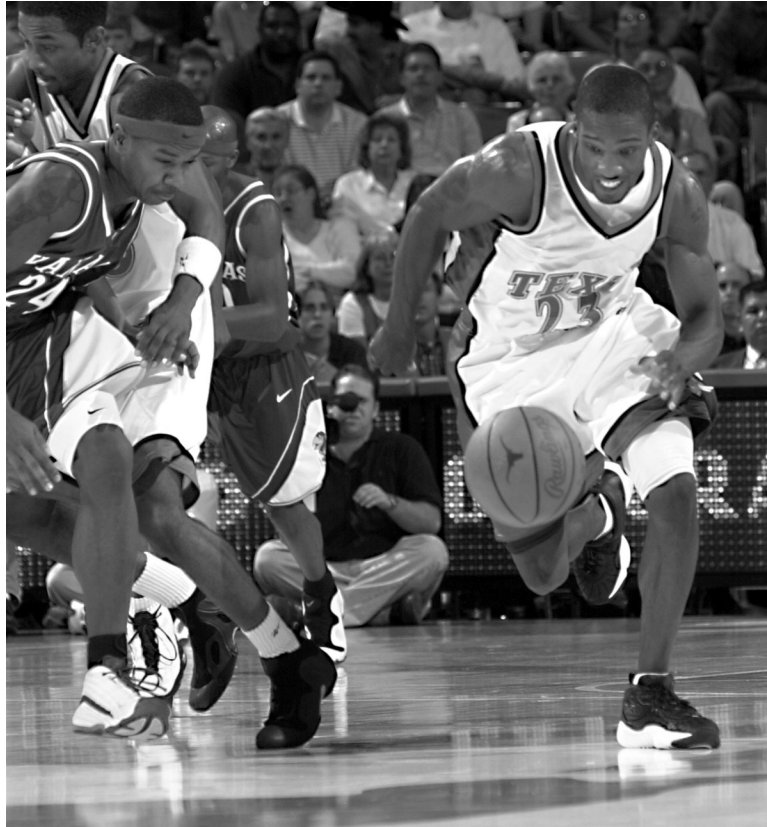


RISKS
